Waste management challenges

- Pollution and lack of environmental awareness
- 70% of waste is incinerated (burned) (Spain)
- No objective methods to reward/penalize polluters

Current solutions fall short

- Safety (accidents, vandalism), pollution, CO2 emissions
- Cost effectiveness is low: investments (CAPEX) and operations (OPEX) are costly

Waste classified and managed at the source

- Proper classification and quantification of waste by measuring the density (garbage unit, bag)
- Automated rewarding of polluters (taxes, access to containers, micro payments, ...)
- Prescribe dynamic collection route for waste operators

Platform to incent polluters

- Connected waste management devices, Internet of Things (IoT)
- Big Data and Artificial Intelligence (AI) analysis
